Minutes of last Meeting having previously been circulated to all councillors were signed as correct by Cllr Steele, proposed Cllr Robertson, seconded Cllr Robinson.

Clerks Comments

- a) Village Green Update. District Cllr Musgrave gave confirmation that Amey have agreed to amend the route so that they reverse into Pump Alley and exit left so no more damage is done to the village green. He also reported that NYCC Highways consider the damage already done as cosmetic and will not carry out any repairs.
- b) Environment Agency Update. No response has been received from EA (Mark Fuller). In the meantime County Cllr Liz Casling has been to a meeting with EA regarding flooding across the district, and she asked Clerk for an update on how Bolton Percy were progressing with obtaining funding. Clerk updated Cllr Casling with details obtained received from NYCC with regard upgrading the road on The Rampart. Cllrs decided to contact Howard Ferguson for his help with Station Road and Hornington Bridge improvement.

Correspondence

1. Village Pump Donations. No response has been received from the two residents of Pump Alley who do not contribute to the Pump Fund. It was decided that Cllr Robinson visit the residents, and explain the history of donations towards the upkeep of the pump.

Reports of Meetings

Yorkshire Water Working Group – 4th July. This meeting took place at The Barn, Crown Inn Bolton Percy. Jonathan Piatka and Joe Harbon (YW) undated all councillors present from the four villages (Bolton Percy, Colton, Appleton Roebuck and Ulleskelf) on the work carried out since the last meeting in April. Appleton Roebuck. A new (partial) collapse has been found of the surface water sewer adjacent the new manhole (Main Street). 8 tons of silt has been taken out from the blockage near Bond Lane (near pub) and roots cut out using a robotic cutter. More CCTV investigation work is planned for this area. De-silting to be carried out at Watson Garth. Pumping Station impellers will the replaced on a maintenance basis. **Bolton Percy.** Lining works have been carried out on the foul system to prevent the ingress of land water in the Pump Alley area (Bumblebee Cottage). More work is planned for Vine Court under the decking. Lifting of manhole lids have been checked and flushed out where necessary. CCTV done upstream from manhole in the field. More infiltration has been found, the pipes to be lined and CCTV work allocated near the Crown Inn. Pumping Station impellers to be replaced on a maintenance basis. requested by Cllr Isherwood, that the telementary in the Pumping Station be re-checked, as it doesn't seem to be working correctly when the pumps trip out. JP to arrange for engineer to attend. The ultra sound and level of the Wet Well also to be checked. Ulleskelf. The pipes have been lined at Algarth Close. It was reported near Cherry Tree Farm water not flowing away. To check if this is NYCC responsibility. This village also has problems with the

telementary system, and will be checked. Otherwise no further problems. JP advised representative from Ulleskelf that he could help with providing sand bags etc, and the

recently formed Flood Group to contact him if required. The main problems in this village are when the river is in flood. **Colton.** 5 manholes have had water pouring in to the pipeline from Bilbrough. Funding has been sanctioned to do more work between Bilbrough and Colton. Fats, oils and grease have been found at the Services. Cleaning out to be done asap. YW to speak to businesses to make sure they have grease traps fitted. **Bilbrough**. There are problems with the Private Pumping Station, and YW will adopt this in October 2016 when work will be done.

Funding is in place for the computer model for the whole area and flow meters will be installed on the whole in September.

The next meeting will be end of September.
