## Clerks Report – Actions from last meeting

- a) Dog Bin Bolton Percy Relocation. The cost to relocate this bin is £62.84 + VAT which are the responsibility of the Parish Council to pay. After speaking with SDC some of the locations suggested are not suitable for vehicle to empty the bin. It was decided to defer the final decision until the November meeting when hopefully all councillors would be present.
- b) School Lane, Bolton Percy Parking. NYCC Highways have confirmed they have contacted the residents on four occasions, (two they had replied to by residents) but no resolution had been done. Councillors confirmed they would leave it to Highways to make further contact and decisions with the householder. Clerk to write to the resident on behalf of the Parish Council.
- **c) Tree Planting.** More information is to investigate as to what kind of trees can be obtained and in what quantity before any final decision is made.
- d) Optimum Bikes Report. Cllr Tucker reported he had met the owner of this company who stated none of his employees were responsible for the speeding bikes on Colton Lane. Customers were not allowed to take the bikes on a test run. Parish Council to review any further concerns.
- e) Clir Robertson to Report on Cricket Club Items. Parish Council are wondering if the Cricket Club would be prepared to plant more trees round their ground once tree options are known Clir Robertson to discuss with CC Chairman. Secondly the Defibrillator. This has been handed over to CC Chairman who sends his thanks for thinking of them. As no charger or instructions was with the unit Cricket Club to purchase. Clir Robertson to pass on contact details for defibrillator accessories and registration advice.
- **f) Broadband Phase 3 Steeton.** Howard Ferguson has come back with an update on the progress on this. Cllr Lister has a copy of this email if anyone would like to read it.

This family are no longer involved and ask their name be taken off. It was explained that SDC continue to add the Ibbotson name on all their planning applications.
