1. CLERKS REPORT – ACTION FROM LAST MEETING

- a) Overflying Aircraft. Stewart Rogerson gave his apologies to Clerk due to a previous appointment he wouldn't be able to be at the start of the meeting and asked this section be postponed until his arrival. When Stewart arrived he confirmed an Aviation Report is still awaited but he had been in touch with the Aviation expert and Planning Officer Nun Appleton Estate had employed on our behalf to which the Parish Council thanked them. It is understood all pilots are requested to read the instruction booklet (some pilots don't have a transponder). A decision is awaited from the CAA regarding the new navigation system at East Leeds Airport which would enable Jet aircraft being able to take off and land.
- b) Yorkshire Water Cllr Nicholls reported on the work being carried out in the local village regarding sewage problems. Mott MacDonald Bentley along with RAMs Safety Solutions have carried out camera survey work on sewers to better understand the network. Infiltration investigation work already carried out in Bilbrough the results will not be made public. Colton work will be carried out at a future date to the new Pumping Station.
- c) Colton Dog Bin Just to notify Colton residents the second bin was ordered on 25th July 2022 awaiting date for fitting.
- **d) First Aid Course Colton** A new date has been arranged with the Ambulance Service. This is FRIDAY 9TH DECEMBER 2022 AT 2.00PM in Colton Church. Residents who were interested originally will be contacted again to see if they are available for the new date
